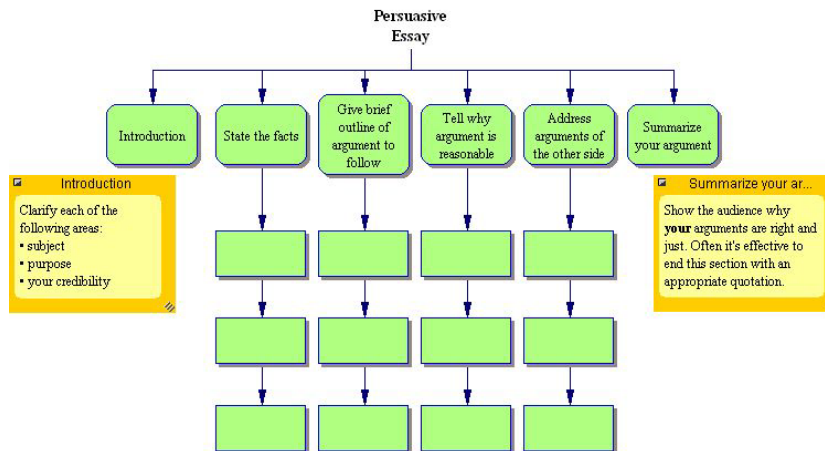
Benefits of using the Literary Comparison template
